noun

- Something that is passed down by preceding generations; a tradition.
- Domesticated livestock or crop of a traditional breed, usually not widely produced for commercial purposes, but possessing historical and/or cultural significance.

Synonyms: heritage, inheritance, legacy, tradition

These nouns denote something immaterial, such as a practice or custom, that is passed from one generation to another.
